PHYSICAL PLANT	<b>86587(a)</b>	Crisis Nurseries shall be clean, safe, sanitary and in good repair.
	<b>86587(e)</b>	Swimming pools, hot tubs, spas, fish ponds and similar bodies of water shall be made inaccessible by covers or fences.
	<b>86587(g)</b>	Disinfectants, cleaning solutions, poisons, and other dangerous items shall be made inaccessible.
	<b>86587(g)(4)</b>	Firearms and other dangerous weapons shall not be allowed into or stored on the Crisis Nursery premises. (Zero Tolerance)
PARTICIPANT RECORDS	<b>86568.1(c)(1)(A)</b>	Upon admission or placement, the crisis nursery shall complete an admission form that includes a family history, child health information, emergency information, dietary requirements, daily needs, habits or routines, and the disciplinary methods used by the parents or guardian.
	<b>86568.1(c)(1)</b>	At the time of admission or placement, the crisis nursery shall obtain information and signed consent forms specified in 86570(b)(1) to (16)
	<b>86568.1(c)(4)(A)</b>	Upon admission or placement, the crisis nursery shall ensure that the authorized representatives understand, sign, and receive a copy of the child's Personal Rights
STAFF RECORDS	<b>86519(e)(1)</b>	Prior to working or volunteering in a Crisis Nursery all individuals shall obtain a California Criminal Record Clearance or exemption.
	<b>86519.2(b)</b>	Prior to employment, residence or initial presence in a Crisis Nursery all individuals shall complete a Child Abuse Index Check (LIC 198A).
	<b>86565(h)(1)</b>	All Crisis Nursery personnel, including the administrator, staff and volunteers, shall have a health screening report signed by a physician not more than one year prior to, or seven days after employment.
	<b>86565(n)</b>	Lead caregivers, caregivers, and volunteers shall have a current and valid certificate verifying successful completion of pediatric first aid and pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation
ADMINISTRATION	<b>86510(a)</b>	A Crisis Nursery shall not operate beyond the conditions and limitations specified on the license. Including the capacity limitation. (Zero Tolerance)
	<b>86505.1(a)</b>	The maximum capacity of a Crisis Nursery shall be 14. (Zero Tolerance)
	<b>86502(a)</b>	All Crisis Nurseries shall obtain and maintain a fire clearance. (Zero Tolerance)
	<b>86522(a)</b>	Crisis Nurseries shall maintain a current written plan of operation
	<b>86523(a)</b>	All Crisis Nurseries shall post current written emergency plans.
	<b>86561(a)(4)</b>	Any suspected physical or psychological abuse or neglect of any child in care shall be reported to the Department and to other reporting agencies by the next business day. (PC 11165.6 and PC 11166)
	<b>86565.5(a)</b>	There shall be at least one fully qualified and employed lead caregiver on site at all times.
